1. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 1930668. This may please be noted and quoted for any further correspondence with the Board.

2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the

Board upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.

3. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.

The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State

/UT Govt from time to time.

5. The school will enrol students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under :-No. of Sections (pre-primary to X)

- 6. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
- 7. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.

8. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.

- 9. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
- 10. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of

11. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

12. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Firefighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.

- 9. Continuous sponsoring of students at board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
- 10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 11. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
- 13. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
- 14. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
- 16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- 18. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- 19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content.
